Absence	the lack of existence, a failure to be present
Archive	the process of documenting for future study
Auxiliary	things made to aid the act of existing
Botanical	discoveries about human nature derived from plants
Controlled	to harness power and direct it, to take charge and command
Efflorescence	the act of blooming
Escape	to slip away, as from confinement or restraint; gain or regain liberty
Ethereal	extremely light and delicate, as if not of this world
Exposure	the act of revealing
Fantastical	indulgent play outside of or away from reality
Femininity	an intricate study of the supposed and not supposed qualities of womanhood
Isolation	a condition of detachment or separation
Loneliness	the space between deep rooted connections between people
Mystical	a spiritual meaning or reality that is neither apparent to the senses nor obvious to the intelligence; an aura of heightened interest surrounding a person or thing
Nostalgic	relating to a past experience, whether or not it actually happened
Playful	happy eagerness
Preservation	to maintain and reserve for continued survival, to protect or spare
Quiescence	to be quiet and still
Sugary	showing or expressing a pleasant emotion in a way that seems excessive and false : too sweet
Taxonomy	a system for naming and organizing things
Transparent	allowing light through so object or idea can be clearly seen entirely
